FYI participants remove excessive pavement and replace it with green infrastructure to take pressure off our stormwater system and reduce flooding.

To date, we have removed
67,277 SF of paving.

FYI provides visible examples of green infrastructure in the urban environment that serve as models and inspiration for future efforts.

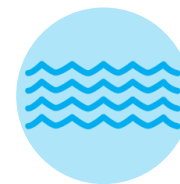
Throughout the city, **115 yards** have been transformed thus far.
